## 01 The world heritage symbolizing Nikko Nikko Toshogu

The shrine where the first shogun, Tokugawa Ieyasu, was enshrined. Ieyasu founded the Edo bakufu (the last feudal Japanese military government). Richly colored sculptures are seen in key places, and representative decorations of the Yomeimon Gate and the Karamon Gate are breathtakingly beautiful.

■ Take a 9-minute bus ride from the Tobu Nikko Station to the "Oatesando" bus stop, and walk 5 minutes

## 02 Feel the wind on your face on this comfortable boat ride Chuzenji Lake Boat cruise

Sightseeing boat cruise around the natural beauty of Lake Chuzenji. You can experience a different charm of Nikko from the comfortable boat.

■ Take a 45-minute bus ride from the Tobu Nikko Station to the "Chuzenji onsen" bus stop, and walk 5 minutes

## 03 The temple where rare statues of Kannon are worshiped Chuzenji Temple, Tachiki Kannon

An ancient temple built in 784 by a priest from Akechidaira to the observatory used by the ropeway. From the window you can see a natural panoramic view. Lake Chuzenji and the Kegan Waterfall will be right below you, and viewing them from here is a unique experience different from seeing them on ground.

■ Take a 45-minute bus ride from the Tobu Nikko Station to the "Chuzenji onsen" bus stop. From there, walk 20 minutes or take a 5-minute bus ride from the "Chuzenji onsen" bus stop to the "Kenji-mimori Chugushi" bus stop, from which it is very close

## 05 Height of 97m, natural dynamism Kegan Falls

This big waterfall boasts one of the prominent sights of beauty of Japan. The way the water falls down at once from a 97 m high cliff conveys the greatness and intensity of nature.

■ Take a 45-minute bus ride from the Tobu Nikko Station to the "Chuzenji onsen" bus stop, and walk 5 minutes

## 07 Discover the origin of the religious belief in Nikko Futarasan Shrine

It is the center of the religious belief in Nikko and its history predates the Nikko Toshogu. The spring water and sacred tree in the precinct are especially popular as they are believed to be beneficial for marriage and good luck.

■ Take a 12-minute bus ride from the Tobu Nikko Station to the "Tayikan Futarasan jinmyae" bus stop, from which it is very close

## 10 Visit the ancient temple founded in Nikko Rinno-ji Temple

It is one of the Grand Head Temples of the Tendai sect, along with Hieiizan Enryakuji Temple and Toisan Kanenji Temple. Three 7.5 m tall Buddhist statues are lined up in the Sambutsudo, a main hall of the style rarely seen in Japan.

■ Take an 8-minute bus ride from the Tobu Nikko Station to the "Shodai shoin 2nd moe" bus stop, from which it is very close

## 11 A tree-lined road reminds you of the old days Suginami Cedar Avenue of Nikko

In the breathtaking landscape, more than 12,000 cedar trees stands along the side of the approx. 37-kilometer road. Some part of the road has not been touched, and the shadows of the Edo period still remain.

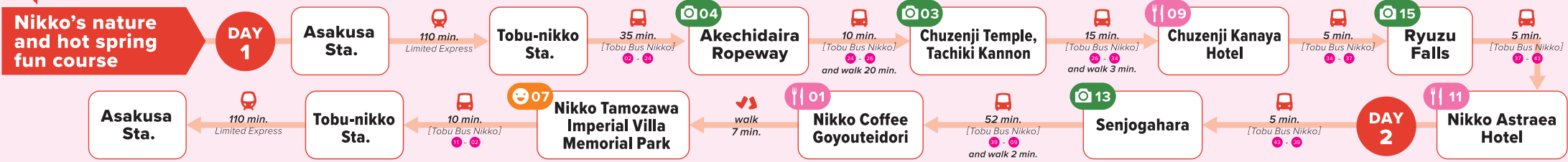

## 14 Run powerfully with the whistle blowing SL "Taiju"

The tourist SL revived to convey the railroad culture to the present. You will be fascinated by its powerful appearance of the steam train runs blowing a whistle.

# 快 Cuisine & Relaxation

The moment when you meet unique local dishes, or when you receive fine hospitality.  
These are some of the unmissable charms of Nikko that gives you a moment of heavenly food and healing time during the visit.



## 01 Aroma-rich coffee brewed with the famous mineral water Nikko Coffee Goyouteidori

You can taste an extraordinary cup of home-roasted coffee brewed with the famous water at an atmospheric cafe which once was an old traditional house. Handmade sweets and shaved ice are also popular.

## 03 Take a blissful rest while watching the waterfall Ryuzu no chaya

With one of the representative waterfalls of Nikko splashing in front of you, you can enjoy the deliciousness that excites the heart of a traveler, such as dumplings or special soup with rice cakes.

■ Take an one-hour bus ride from the Tobu Nikko Station to the "Ryuzu no taki" bus stop, from which it is very close

## 05 Carefully selected local dishes made with river fish Funabatei

A restaurant where you can enjoy simple but flavourful river fish and rural dishes. Their specialty is chuffy-salt-grilled sweetfish with crispy skin, roasted over charcoal.

## 07 Heartwarming restaurant with a reputation Nikko Kujira Shokudo

You can enjoy the dishes made with the local special pork and vegetables in a homey atmosphere. Their specialty is the popular fluffy and moist rice omelette, covered with plenty of white sauce.

## 10 Set meal to taste the local flavors Nikko Yubamaki ZEN

The restaurant is famous for sushi rolls using tofu skin instead of seaweed. Their original dishes using plenty of Tochigi wagyu and local vegetables are also popular.

■ Take a 5-minute bus ride from the Tobu Nikko Station to the "Shinkyō" bus stop, and walk 2 minutes

## 13 Fluffy natural shaved ice Shogetsuhimuro

A specialty store of shaved ice directly managed by the natural ice manufacturer, which is rare in Japan. The popular item is Namaichigo Premium covered with plenty of local strawberries sauce.

## 14 A hotel filled with luxurious relaxation Kinugawa Grand Hotel Yumenotoki

A hotel where the seasonal scenery can be seen from each room. Nine types of baths and five types of reserved outdoor baths will heal the tiredness of the trip.

## 02 A hotel loved by prominent figures Nikko Kanaya Hotel

The oldest resort hotel in Japan, where Einstein stayed once. The decoration resembling Toshogu has a stunning historical value worth seeing.

■ Take a 5-minute bus ride from the Tobu Nikko Station to the "Shinkyō" bus stop, and walk 2 minutes

## 04 Casual place to enjoy hotel quality taste Kanaya Hotel Rekishikan Cottage In Restaurant

The resort hotel with its long history and proud traditions offers a variety of menus served with breads made by Kanaya Hotel Bakery. The restaurant has a bakery next to it.

■ Take a 10-minute bus ride from the Tobu Nikko Station to the "Kanaya Hotel Rekishikan" bus stop, from which it is very close

## 06 A peaceful cafe inside a traditional house Nikko Hongu Café

A café in a renovated 300 year old building in the shrine precincts. Its hard to choose from the unique flavors of Japanese sweets and coffee that are served here.

■ Take a 5-minute bus ride from the Tobu Nikko Station to the "Shinkyō" bus stop, and walk 2 minutes

## 09 Experience the hospitality in the nature Chuzenji Kanaya Hotel

A log cabin style resort hotel located in Nikko National Park. You can enjoy Kanaya hotel's traditional full-course French cuisine and the open spa surrounded by forests.

## 11 Relaxing under the starry sky and in natural hot springs Nikko Astraea Hotel

Natural spiritual resort hotel in Oku-Nikko is the perfect location to view the night sky. Relax under the starry sky, in the open spa which uses water that comes directly from the source of Nikko Yumoto.

## 12 Enjoy the flavor of tofu skin by eating rice balls Fudarakuhompo

The famous "Yubamusubi" at the old Japanese confectionery store, a third generation family business, is quick to be sold out. Enjoy the taste of the moist Yuba (tofu skin) and glutinous rice.

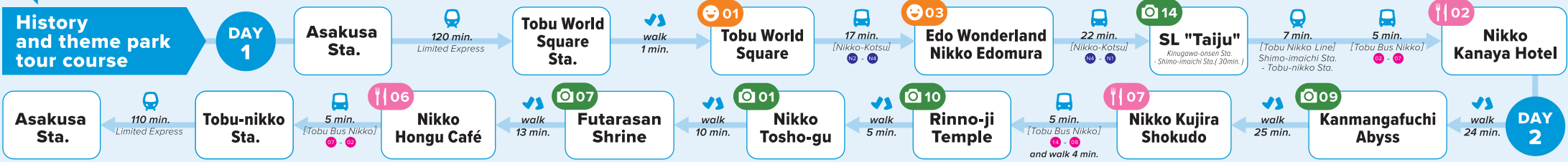

Ningyo yaki made to look like monkeys, cats, and dragons familiar in Toshogu have a simple flavor. With the help of their cute appearance, they are a staple item for souvenirs in Nikko.

# 楽 Entertainment & Activities

You can enjoy experiencing Japanese cultural activities such as kimono rental and making local crafts, or feeling nature through Kinugawa line down. It has a lot of spots that you can enjoy yourself.



## 01 Realistic miniature world! Take a tour around the miniature world Tobu World Square

When you get lost in the theme park, it is a photogenic space with miniatures. You will be welcomed by 102 buildings of 22 countries, including world heritage sites reproduced on the 1:25 scale.

## 03 Theme park where you can meet Ninja and Samurai Edo Wonderland Nikko Edomura

A wonderland of recreated Edo period streets. You can enjoy the whole day by watching the Ninja shows, or by dressing and acting like people in the past.

## 05 Experience the spirit of Japan by wearing Kimono COCON NIKKO Kimono Rental

Let's change into a Kimono and go out for a special walking experience on the old streets in Nikko. The basic set plan including Kimono and accessories is 4,400 yen for a day.

## 07 Experience the history of the Imperial Family Nikko Tamozawa Imperial Villa Memorial Park

An important national cultural asset with the combined architectural styles of the Edo, Meiji, and Taisho periods. It is well known as priceless architecture that preserves the essence of the historical Imperial family culture.

■ Take a 10-minute bus ride from the Tobu Nikko Station to the "Nikko Tamozawa Goytei Kinenken" bus stop, from which it is very close

## 09 Satisfy your curiosity at the farm Nikko Kirfurikogen Ozasa ranch

A barbecue with thick lamb meat and soft serve ice creams made with fresh milk from rare brown Swiss cows are incredibly delicious. At the Food Workshop, anyone from children to adults can enjoy themselves at a butter-making activity weekends, etc. between the end of April and the early November.

## 12 Casually experience traditional engraving Murakami Toyohachi Shouten

You can casually experience Nikko carving (Nikko-bon) at the old shop which has preserved the carving skills of Nikko. Make a one-of-a-kind engraving for a memory of your trip. \*Reservation required

## 13 Feel close to the nature of Okunikko Nikko Natural Science Museum

There are plenty of things to see such as a theater introducing the four seasons of Okunikko with powerful images and an exhibition on the local nature.

■ Take a 45-minute bus ride from the Tobu Nikko Station to the "Chuzenji onsen" bus stop, from which it is very close



## 02 Take in the four seasons while relaxing in the famously cloudy water Yumoto Hot Spring, Okunikko

A hot spring resort located on the plateau at an altitude of about 1,500 m, where you can enjoy the scenery that changes every season. It is close to Senjogahara and Odashirogahara, making it the perfect base for trekking.

## 04 Enjoy the beauty of the gorge from the boat Kinugawa River Boat Ride

You will be able to feel the calmness and excitement of the Kinugawa River. You will be surrounded by the fascinating dynamism of the gorge in the Kinugawa River and the beautiful scenery.

## 06 A view like a landscape painting British Embassy Villa Memorial Park

This building was once used as the British Embassy Villa. The view over Lake Chuzenji from the spacious veranda on the second floor gives visitors peace of mind.

■ Take a 45-minute bus ride from Tobu Nikko Station to "Chuzenji onsen" bus stop. From there, walk 30 minutes or take a 5-minute bus ride to the "Itara-Eikokukaisikan Bessō kinenken Iriguchi" bus stop (only operating in the summer and the autumn leaf season), and walk 5 minutes

## 08 Modern architecture built with care Italian Embassy House Memorial Park

A tangible cultural property of Japan, this restored building was used as the Italian Embassy Villa. The captivatingly beautiful architectural style cherishes harmony with nature.

■ Take a 45-minute bus ride from Tobu Nikko Station to "Chuzenji onsen" bus stop. From there, walk 35 minutes or take a 5-minute bus ride to the "Itara-Eikokukaisikan Bessō kinenken Iriguchi" bus stop (only operating in the summer and the autumn leaf season), and walk 10 minutes

## 10 Drink up the traditions of the sake brewer Katayama Shuzo

A venerable sake brewery founded in 1880. It is nice to sample the light-flavored sake brewed by the traditional methods at a store in the warehouse.

## 11 Play in the snow at the family skiing area Nikkoyumoto Ski Area

A ski resort featuring beginner courses with gentle slopes. It is the best spot to visit in winter; it is open from late December to the end of March.

■ Take an 85-minute bus ride from the Tobu Nikko Station to the "Yumoto Onsen" bus stop, and walk 5 minutes

## 14 Unrestrained hiking across the majestic Okunikko while being charmed by the beauty of the lake and waterfall. Hike on the Senjogahara

Most of the Nikko Senjogahara Hike course is downhill, so it can be safely navigated on foot. The course is approximately 4.7 kilometers from "Tobu Nikko Station" to the "Senjogahara Information Center" and is provided in cooperation with the local residents and other spots of flora and fauna. Scenes of the cotton grass in full bloom around June are especially beautiful with the white cotton scattered throughout the meadows.
