This travel pass for foreign travelers features one round-trip train ticket from Asakusa as well as discount fares for bus and train services in the Nikko and Kinugawa Onsen area. Choose the travel pass that fits your trip.


Q26 Mount Nantai and Lake Chuzenji (sightseeing of A lake formed when a lava flow from Mount Nantai blocked a gorge.




Senjogahara An expansive approx. 400-hectare wetland located at an elevation of approx. 1400 meters.

Visit the many iconic temples and shrines of Nikko, including the world heritage sites of Nikko Toshogu Shrine, Nikko Rinnoji Temple, and Nikko Futarasan Shrine. This pass is ideal for travelers who want to explore Nikko during a day trip or overnight trip.

983 Nikkosan Rinnoji Temple (Taiyuin Temple) Omotemon The grave site of Tokugawa lemitsu featuring stately and subdued architecture.



98 Nikko Futarasan Shrine A popular shrine worship



rasan Shrine (Shinkyo Bridge) A lacquered bridge believed to be once crossed by Shodo Shonin upon opening of temples in the mountains of Nikko.



Kinugawa Onsen Town (get off at Kinugawa Onsen Station) A historical hot spring resort once only open to monks and daimyo (feudal lords) during the Edo period.



28 Kanmangafuchi Abyss A natural wonder created by lava from Mount Nantai. There is a grouping of approx. 70 Jizo statues on the south bank.



SL Taiju is a nostalgic steam locomotive that runs three round-trips daily between Shimo-Imachi and Kinugawa Onsen. *SL reserved seat ticket is required



Tobu Tourist Information Center Asakusa provides information to foreign travelers about tourism spots in Nikko, Kinugawa Onsen, Asakusa as well as along Tobu Railway lines. It also sells various types of train tickets. Staff speak English, Chinese, Korean and Thai. Purchases are only accepted in Japanese currency. Major credit cards are accepted. (However, not all credit cards are accepted.)

How to purchase the NIKKO PASS

The NIKKO PASS is available for purchase at the Tobu Tourist Information Center Asakusa starting one month prior to travel. <Note> NIKKO PASS is only available to foreign travelers. However, Japanese nationals accompanying foreign travelers can also purchase the pass. Refunds will be accepted at any sales outlet as long as the pass is unused and still valid. (A separate cancellation fee applies.)
